

Pillow Case Project

Opportunity for our **Brownies** and **Juniors** Scouts from the American Red Cross.

The **American Red Cross** is offering a free one hour class for our Brownies and Junior Scouts called "Pillow Case Project." The class takes about an hour and the trained American Red Cross volunteer is willing to come to a troop meeting. Each child receives a pillow case and workbook and through this presentation gains new knowledge about preparedness for emergencies.

Preparation education teaches the students about personal family preparedness, local hazards and basic coping skills. Program leads students through "learn, practice, share" framework to engage them in disaster preparedness. Students receive a sturdy American Red Cross pillow case upon completion of the one hour program in which they are encouraged to build a personal emergency supply kit.
