Other Educational Programs offered:

- "Creek Critters" for B/J/C April through September Join a naturalist at Peaks View Park to get hands on experience with creek critters living in Cheese Creek. The girls will collect and study macroinverterbrates, run water quality tests, lean about watersheds and more.
- 2. "Birding 101" for J/C/S/A and offered all year round. Girls will build a better understanding of birds and migration search the sky and trees for birds while hiking the trails with a naturalist learn about bird identification, bird habits, how to use binoculars and more.
- 3. "Maple Sugaring" for D/B/J/C/S/A offered January and February. Girls will learn how to identify trees to be tapped, demonstrate how to tap a tree, learn the history and process of maple sugaring...
